



KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO REMAIN SILENT!



DON'T RUN

Stay calm and don't run. Running may be seen as an admission of guilt.



DON'T CARRY FALSE DOCUMENTS

Providing false documents to ICE may result in deportation and criminal charges.



DON'T OPEN YOUR DOOR

You're not normally required to open the door to anyone. Immigration and the police can't come into your home without a warrant signed by judge.



REMAIN SILENT

You have the right to remain silent. Immigration can use anything you say against you.



DON'T SIGN ANY DOCUMENTS

Ask to speak to your attorney and think twice before signing anything. A lawyer who knows deportation defense may be able to help you.



YOU MAY NEED LEGAL DEFENSE

Seek support from an immigration attorney and keep your data at hand.



HAVE A CARE PLAN FOR YOUR CHILDREN

As soon as you can, ask the agent to give you let him call that person to take care of this children. Complete and affidavit of legal guardian (Caregiver Affidavit).
